Morning Session

Senate session will open with an overview on how the legislative process works. Then, Senators will divide into Senate committees to discuss bills, take positions on legislation, and actually draft legislation for the full Senate to consider. Committees will include Communications and Technology, Education, Judiciary, Law and Justice, State Government and Transportation.
