Right to Carry for Dog Wardens Act

An act to allow dog wardens the use of stun guns and firearms in the performance of his or her duties.

Section 1. Definitions

The following words and phrases when used in this act shall have, unless the context clearly indicates otherwise, the meanings given to them in this section:

“Stun gun.” A device that is designed to emit an electronic, magnetic or other type of charge to temporarily immobilize or incapacitate.

Section 2. Requirements

A firearm or stun gun training program created by the Pennsylvania State Police to provide wardens with basic training in the use and handling of firearms and stun guns.

This act shall take effect in 90 days.
