Lowering Pennsylvania's Driving Age to 15

AN ACT

Section 1. Amending the Pennsylvania Driving Code to allow 15-year-olds to apply for a learner's permit.

Section 2. Definitions.

- a. "Learner's permit." a restricted license issued to individuals learning to operate a motor vehicle.

Section 3. Eligibility.

- a. Any individual who is 15 years of age may apply for a learner's permit.
- b. Pass a written knowledge test administered by the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation.
- c. Obtain parental consent.

Section 4. This act will take effect in 30 days.
