Lowering the Age from 18 to 16 Years Old to Handle, Serve and Dispense Alcohol in a
Restaurant

AN ACT

Section 1. Amending the Pennsylvania Liquor Code to allow any person over the age of 16 years old to handle, serve and dispense alcohol in a restaurant.

Section 2. Definitions.

- a. "Handle." Buying, selling or distributing of alcohol.
- b. "Serve." Delivering of an alcoholic product to consumer.
- c. "Dispense." The pouring of an alcoholic product.

Section 3. This act will take effect in 90 days.
