Allowing High School Students to Vote in Local School Board Elections

AN ACT

Section 1. Amending Pennsylvania's Election Code to allow a high school student to vote in local school board elections.

Section 2. Definitions.

- a. "High School Student." a person age 14, 15, 16, 17, 18 years old and is enrolled in an accredited high school education program approved by the Pennsylvania Department of Education.
- b. "Student Voter Identification Card." a card that displays the students name, grade year and school year.

Section 3. The Department of State will provide a Student Voter Identification Card to each high school student in the state of Pennsylvania.

Section 4. Student Voter Identification Card will need to be presented to a county election official to obtain a ballot.

Section 5. This act shall take effect January 1, 2027.
