Defining privacy rights on social media and penalizing the offense of cyber bullying.

AN ACT

- Section 1. This act shall be known as "Privacy Rights and No More Cyber Bullying Act".
- Section 2. This would amend the Pennsylvania Crimes Code to define privacy rights that minors (defined as under 18 years of age) have on social media outlets.
- Section 3. This would further define "cyber bullying" as the intent of a minor to harass, annoy or intimidate another minor.
- Section 4. Penalties for this crime would result in a third degree misdemeanor, with a third or subsequent offense constitution a second degree misdemeanor.
- Section 5. Effective Date: This act shall take effect on January 1, 2023.
