BILL NO.	TITLE OF BILL	ACTION
<b>SENATE 1</b>	<b>Parental Consent to Join Online Social Media Networks (Communications and Technology)</b> An Acting stating a social media company may not approve the creation of an account for a minor without written consent of the minor's parent or legal guardian.	
<b>SENATE 2</b>	<b>Banning TikTok (Communications and Technology)</b> An Act banning TikTok from usage in the Commonwealth.	
<b>SENATE 3</b>	<b>Curriculum Transparency in K-12 Schools (Education)</b> An Act stating a school entity shall post an internet link or title for every textbook, a course syllabus, or a written summary of each instructional course.	
<b>SENATE 4</b>	<b>Student Teacher Stipend Program (Education)</b> An Act stating a student teacher shall receive a minimum grant of \$10,000 through the Department of Education.	
<b>SENATE 5</b>	<b>Constitutional Carry of a Firearm (Judiciary)</b> An Act stating that every person present in this Commonwealth who is not already prohibited from possession firearms shall have a constitutional right to keep and bear firearms.	
<b>SENATE 6</b>	<b>Abolishing the Death Penalty (Judiciary)</b> An Act stating the death penalty will no longer be offered as a means of punishment for certain levels of murder and arson.	
<b>SENATE 7</b>	<b>Allowing for Armed School Personnel (Law and Justice)</b> An Act stating school personnel are permitted to have access to firearms in school buildings and on school grounds with regulations.	
<b>SENATE 8</b>	<b>Legalization of Marijuana (Law and Justice)</b> An Act stating the sale of marijuana is legal to those over 18 years old with regulations.	
<b>SENATE 9</b>	<b>Voter Identification to Vote (State Government)</b> An Act stating that a qualified elector shall provide a valid identification at each election.	
<b>SENATE 10</b>	<b>Changing the Required Voting Age to 16 Years Old (State Government)</b> An Act stating that every citizen over the age of 16 years old shall be entitled to vote.	
<b>SENATE 11</b>	<b>Distracted Driving (Transportation)</b> An Act stating no driver shall operate a motor vehicle while using a wireless device, eating or drinking, smoking, applying make-up, or using a navigation system.	
<b>SENATE 12</b>	<b>Tax on Electric Vehicles (Transportation)</b> An Act stating that there shall be a \$300 tax on all electric and hybrid vehicles.
